

Guidelines for “Walk Through Service”

- ⤴ Branches will operate on this schedule:
Mon. - Wed., 10 a.m. – 6 p.m., Thurs. – Fri., 10 a.m. – 5 p.m., Sat., 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.
- ⤴ Curbside pickup of materials will continue during operating hours.
- ⤴ Recommended social distancing standards limit the number of people allowed in library buildings.
- ⤴ Face coverings are required to enter a library branch. Masks will be provided for patrons who do not have one. If a medical condition precludes wearing a mask, curbside service will be offered.
- ⤴ Everyone entering a library branch must complete a health survey and provide contact information.
- ⤴ Furniture and seating are reserved for computer/laptop users who may be asked to limit their use to one hour. All others are encouraged to leave the library after completing their transactions.
- ⤴ The Warrenton Virginiana Room circulating resources are available upon request for checkout. The room is closed for in-person research.
- ⤴ Bins are available in high use areas for patrons to place items they have handled but decided not to check out.
- ⤴ No cash will be collected or dispersed; patrons may pay their fines/fees online and must bring exact change to use the copier.
- ⤴ Children nine years of age or younger must be directly supervised at all times by an adult.

- ^ If children nine years of age or younger are left unattended, staff will attempt to contact their parents/guardians. If they cannot be reached, staff will contact appropriate authorities.
